Team Paperwork Checklist & Instructions

Instructions for team paperwork, including due dates, are listed below. Forms can be found on <u>https://mrssa.org</u> and <u>www.usawaterski.org</u>. *Incomplete or late paperwork will result in a \$50.00 fee.

Upload ALL paperwork, no printing required. The tournament committee will print the paperwork & distribute at the required meeting on Friday, July 28, 2023, immediately following the individual competition. A team representative **MUST** be present. If you have any questions, please email <u>tournamentfiles@gmail.com</u>.

Due by July 14th:

- **Submit payment**: \$425 Entry Fee via Venmo @waterhawksskiteam OR mail a check to Waterhawks Ski Team, postmarked no later than 7/14/23 (Waterhawks Ski Team, % Tournament, P.O. Box 112, Waterloo, IA 50704).
- Complete & submit the <u>Online Team Entry Form</u>. To complete this form, you are required to upload the following:
 - USA-WSWS CLUB Membership Card
 - USA-WSWS Team's SAFETY's Membership Card
 - <u>USA-WSWS Club MEMBER Roster</u>: This roster includes name, membership number, SafeSport status, and renewal date for each member. To export the roster, use the export button.
 - <u>USA-WSWS Club OFFICIALS Roster</u>: This roster includes the team's safety coordinator, tournament drivers, show director's SafeSport certification with background check, etc. To export this roster, use the export button.
 - Team Roster: This is your own team-generated roster & will be cross-referenced with your USA-WSWS Club Member Roster, and they MUST match. It needs to include: name, USA-WSWS member #, membership expiration date, SafeSport expiration date, team duty (D=Driver, R=Rider, A=Announcer, SK=Skier, SD=Show Director, ASD=Asst Show Director, O=Other), etc.
 - Tournament Driver's Record
 - Towboat Liability Form
 - Certificate of Insurance OR the Declaration Pages for each of the boats, with the following: certificate holder & additional insured (USA-WSWS), and each boat's liability limit (a minimum of \$500,000 is required).
 - Kite Flying USHPA membership card (if applicable): The pilot must be a member of the USHPA (United States Hang Gliding and Paragliding Association) and is required to be rated as "Hang 2" (novice) or better. Rule 6.04: the pilot(s) must provide a copy of the current USHPA

membership card(s) with the tournament paperwork.

• **Kite Flying - Manufacturer's Sticker (if applicable):** The pilot must use a hang glider produced by a commercial hang glider manufacturer. Rule 6.04: the pilot(s) must provide a copy of the hang glider manufacturer's sticker(s) with the tournament paperwork.

Due by July 26th:

- Complete and submit the <u>Online Paperwork Submission Form</u>. To complete this form, you are required to upload the following:
 - REVISED <u>USA-WSWS Club Member Roster</u>, <u>USA-WSWS Officials Roste</u>r, and/or Team-Generated Roster, <u>ONLY IF changes</u> were made after submitting the entry form by July 14th.
 - Judge's Form
 - Scorer's Form
 - NSSA Safety Director's Tracking Report Form
 - Skier Nomination Form
 - <u>Team History Form</u>
 - Wireless Microphone Frequency/Club Radio Frequency

If there are any changes to your team's paperwork, *after you have electronically submitted*, you are **responsible for bringing the revised paperwork for replacement**. Be sure to know how many copies you need . If no changes are required, your paperwork will be printed & distributed at the team meeting on Friday night.

TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE:

Teams are required to participate in a Safety meeting prior to their setup. This meeting includes boat drivers, pinners, riders, and skiers. **The formal schedule will be provided by the Safety Director & Head Judge to team reps on Friday night**. *NOTE: The first team to ski, on both days, are scheduled to have their safety meeting at 6:45am unless the Safety Director & Head Judge provides a different schedule on Friday night.* ALL other oteams should expect their safety meeting to take place 1-hour prior to set up time. Check with your team rep for the formal schedule.
