Parking

The best parking option is the [Waseca Fairgrounds](#), located about 1.5 miles from the ski site. **Skiers, please plan to drop off your equipment at Sportsman's Park** before heading to the Fairgrounds to park.

Shuttle service will be available to transport you between the Fairgrounds and the ski site.

The schedule is still being finalized, and we'll share details as soon as they're confirmed.

Parking is \$5 per day (cash only)

2-day and 3-day passes will also be available for purchase.

Equipment Parking

Equipment parking is available at [Memorial Park](#). Please park as compactly as possible. You're welcome to leave equipment overnight if needed.

Staging Area updated 7/25/25 @8am

The staging area is going to be **just east of the swingset in the park.** This is between where the front and back dock will be located. Please be careful pulling vehicle and trailer into the area.

The parking lot at the boat launch will be for Officials and workers only. Boats that are being launched will also be allowed there. **Once finished, the equipment will need to be moved to Memorial park.** We are still working on shuttle options and will update once we have more information.

There will not be a traditional beer tent. You are welcome to bring your own alcohol.

Due to heavy overnight rainfall, the Bayside site was placed under a no-wake order through the weekend. This was entirely unforeseen, and we're doing our best to keep the tournament moving forward.
