# MORE VENUE INFO

## Show Course

The length of the show course from the performance platform to the usable right end of the lake is approx. 1600ft. From the left far end to the performance platform is 1700 ft.

The widest portion of the lake is: 550 ft. With the narrowest turn point at 300ft across the lake.

The lake tapers down at each end, with the water depth remaining around 20 feet until 50 feet from each end.

- Our show course includes an approx. 275+ feet of beach allowing skiers to land safely in sand and present on a carpeted concrete stage. The water depth two feet from the beach is approximately 2 ft.
- Also, included in our show course is a tournament legal jump. The water depth off around the jump area is approximately 22 ft.
- Performance platform is a carpeted wood. The water depth off the end of the platform is approximately 10 ft.
- Based upon the size and depth, virtually all of our lake is available for skiing.
- There are no air obstructions.

## Stages

Staging Area: The staging area, and each of the four pre-staging areas, is approximately 1,400 square feet. The areas are large enough for each team to spread out their equipment and park one equipment vehicle at the end of it. The pre-staging areas are very close to the available staging area, and clubs can ski their shows right out of them.

Main Stage: This stage is 10ft wide by 80ft long, constructed of carpeted concrete. All sides are accessible; either by water, sand beach, or down a 6-foot ladder stairway. Our main stage features a 6 ft. retaining wall that allows the spectators the opportunity to truly experience a show ski performance. By creating an elevated perspective for better viewing of the show on the water, and a limited vantage point to anticipate the next skit. Allowing both skiers and stage to tell their stories.

Landing area: The entire distance between the performance platform and the right dock is available for landing with a sand beach that runs the entire distance. There aren't any water hazards in this area. The beach is combed regularly to remove any rocks uncovered by the waves.

## Docks

There are multiple docks available for use. Starting left of the stage, there are four docks and two to the right of the stage.

- The main dock is 42ft. long by 20 ft. wide. The dock is floating, but very stable. Skiers can enter the water from any of the three water facing sides.
- Left dock aka safety dock is 20ft long by 6ft wide. Easy Dock.
- Behind the safety dock is our back dock; this dock is 36ft long by 14ft wide
- The far left dock aka our Floater which is 52ft long by 8ft wide. This floater is hooked up to a permanent smaller dock on the west side of the lake.
- The right dock aka jump dock is 21ft long by 10ft wide. This is a secured floating dock with a carpeted wood base and a connecting walkway. Easy Dock.
- The far right dock aka barefoot dock is 1600ft from main dock, it measures 40ft long by 8ft wide. The dock is securely floating with a connected walkway. Easy Dock.

## Jump

The jump used by the Waterhawks meets all specifications outlined by rule 9.03 of the NSSA rulebook. Our jump has a continuous land-based water source, eliminating the concern of a water failure. Our lake is equipped with a kicker jump that is permanently secured at 330ft from the main dock.

## Judging

Our site features a 48-foot raised judges' area. It is permanently covered with openings on three sides for easy viewing of the show course, much of the lake itself, and the main stage. Our judges' area is housed in a fully enclosed building conducive for scoring, judges' meetings, and separate areas to eat. Specific restrooms will be positioned for judges' use only. The office that is used for scorers is climate-controlled.
